FROM ALBANY TO HOTEL  
7655 BOULEVARD DÉCARIE

- Take I-87 N toward Saratoga Springs (Crossing into Canada\*)
- I-87 N becomes SR 15N.
- Take Exit 53 toward SR-15N/SR-20/SR-10/Pont Champlain/Montréal/Sherbrooke/Québec.
- Stay straight to go onto Boulevard Marie-Victorin.
- Take right ramp for SR-10W/SR-15N/SR-20 W toward Pont Champlain/Montréal
- Merge onto SR 15 N.i
- Take Exit 69; take ramp right toward Rue Jean-Talon/Rue De La Savane.
- Stay straight to go onto Boulevard Décarie.

FROM TORONTO TO HOTEL

- Head east on King's Hwy 401/MacDonald-Cartier Fwy
- Continue onto Route 20 E
- Continue onto QC-540 N/Route 540N (signs for Mirabel/QC-540/QC-40)
- Take the QC-40, exit on the left toward Mirabel/Montréal
- Keep right at the fork toward QC-40 E/TC E and merge onto QC-40 E/TC E
- Take exit 66-S on the left toward QC-15/QC-10/Montréal/Pont Champlain
- Merge onto QC-15 S/Route 15 S
- Take exit 69 toward Rue Jean-Talon/Av. Van Horne/Ch. de la Côte-Ste-Catherine
- Turn left at Rue Paré
- Take the 1st left onto Boulevard Décarie

FROM BUFFALO/SYRACUSE TO HOTEL

- Head north on I-81 N toward Exit 17 (Crossing into Canada\*)
- Continue onto King's Hwy 137--Partial toll road
- Take the ON-401 exit toward Ottawa/Montréal
- Merge onto King's Hwy 401/MacDonald-Cartier Fwy
- Follow directions FROM TORONTO above

\*Passport or other ID such as enhanced driver's license needed at border

#### HOTEL TO SHAARE ZEDEK

- Start out going Southwest on Rue Paré toward Boulevard Décarie
- Turn left onto Boulevard Décarie.
- Turn Slight Left to take the SR-15S ramp.
- Merge onto SR 15Si
- Exit 66 toward Ch. Queen-Mary / Ch. Côte St-Luc.
- Stay straight onto Boulevard Décarie.
- Turn right onto Chemin Queen Mary
- Turn left onto Ellerdale Rd / Rue Ellerdale.
- Turn right onto Côte-St-Luc Rd / Chemin De La Côte-St-Luc.
- Turn left onto Avenue Rosedale
- 5305 Avenue Rosedale is on the left

#### HOTEL TO BETH EL

- Depart Boulevard Décarie
- Turn right onto Rue de la Savane
- Turn left onto Avenue Kindersley
- Turn right onto Chemin Lucerne
- Arrive at 1000 Lucerne Rd, Mont Royal

#### HOTEL TO SHAARE ZION

- Depart Boulevard Décarie
- Make a U-turn at Rue Ferrier
- Take the ramp on the left to QC-15/Route 15S
- Take exit 66 for Ch. Queen-Mary toward Ch. de la Côte-St-Luc
- Merge onto Boulevard Décarie
- Arrive at 5575 Chemin de la Côte-St-Luc, Montréal
