The first person to hold the Women's League Chair in Jewish Gender and Women's Studies, affectionately known as the Billie Rubinoff Chair, Dr. Siegmund is associate professor of History and chair of the program in Jewish Gender and Women's Studies at The Jewish Theological Seminary. It is especially meaningful that she is with us on Founder's Day as Billie Rubinoff was the Founder of the South Jersey Branch—an integral part of our Region.



A specialist in the history of the Jewish family and the Jews of the early modern Italian states, her current research focuses on the subject of conversion of Jews to Catholicism in sixteenth-century Italy. Deeply involved with questions concerning gender and its role in creating Jewish custom, culture, and law, and the history and status of Jewish women, Dr. Siegmund is this year teaching a new course on the pre-modern history of Jewish marriage, as well as early modern Jewish history, and offering a seminar on Jewish Gender Studies.



For those interested in furthering their study, Rabbi Andra Merow of Beth Shalom Congregation of Elkins Park has been asked to lead an afternoon study session. Additionally, World of Women's League™ will include tables of Information on Leadership Institute to Distance Workshops to Biennial Convention 2010 in Baltimore.
